## **Introducer's Statement of Intent**

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

Legislative Bill 103 amends current law, in Section 79-2,136, to require public school boards to establish procedures and policies allowing the participation in extracurricular activities, as defined in Section 79-2,126, of home school students that are enrolled part-time in their school district.

Currently, Nebraska requires public school boards to have policies and procedures in places to allow for part-time enrollment of home school students in academic courses. This bill would allow these part-time home school students the oportunity to participate in extracurricular activities, without having to meet a half-time or up to full-time enrollment requirement. In LB103, public school boards may require no more than one course for credit for part-time home school students to be eligible for extracurricular activities.
