The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:
LB29 gives parents and guardians the right to decide if their child(ren) will submit to a state mandated health inspection and removes the Department of Health and Human Services ability to mandate a new health inspection for all school children without approval by the Legislature.
LB29 also allows a health inspection performed by a physican, physican assistant, advanced practice registered nurse, dentist, or an optometrist on or after May 1 to be valid for the immediately preceding school year.
LB29 does not prevent schools from offering height, weight, BMI or other health checks with a parent or guardian's approval.
