The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB965 amends the Security, Privacy, and Dissemination of Criminal History Information Act. It provides that if a person is arrested and charged as a result of another person using his/her identifying information or because of mistaken identity and the conviction is set aside or on a finding of not guilty, the person can petition to have his/her record expunged. The court shall order that other public entities, e.g. correctional services, law enforcement agencies, Dept. of Motor Vehicles, to expunge their records as well.
