 2 include a commemorative certificate"; after line 18 insert the following
 3 new subdivision:

"(4) Commemorative certificate means a document commemorating a 4 5 nonviable birth;"; in line 19 strike "(4)", show as stricken, and insert "(5)"; in line 21 strike "(5)" and insert "(6)"; in line 24 after "(1)" 6 insert "(a)"; in line 28 after the second "a" insert "commemorative"; in 7 line 30 strike "certifying" and insert "verifying"; and in line 31 after 8 the period insert "The health care practitioner may delegate this duty to 9 his or her designee. In lieu of a letter, the health care practitioner or 10 his or her designee may provide the patient with a form provided by the 11 department pursuant to subdivision (b) of this subsection and executed by 12 13 the health care practitioner or his or her designee.

14 (b) The department shall provide on its web site a form to be 15 executed by a health care practitioner or his or her designee affirming 16 that a patient experienced a nonviable birth that the health care 17 practitioner attended or diagnosed.".

19 <u>nonviable birth</u>".

3. On page 3, line 1, after "<u>letter</u>" insert "<u>or executed form</u>"; in lines 2, 4, 5, 7, 9, 14, 15, and 17, before "<u>certificate</u>" insert <u>commemorative</u>"; and in line 12 before both occurrences of "<u>certificate</u>" insert "<u>commemorative</u>".

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
