Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 1115 would require that the population basis for redistricting for all electoral district in Nebraska except Congress, the Board of Regents, and the Board of Education be total population less noncitizens.

Explanation of amendments:

AM2664 removes supreme court districts from the bill and makes a technical change to conform to Census Bureau terminology.
