Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 317 would clarify and expand the process for a city of the second class or village to relevy or reassess a special assessment that has been declared void or invalid. Under the bill, the authority to relevy or reassess a special assessment would mirror the authority given to cities of the first class.

Explanation of amendments:

AM 19 would make technical changes to correlate with changes made to Nebraska Revised Statute Section 17-703 by LB 133 (Urban Affairs), a clean-up bill of statutes governing cities of the second class and villages.
