Summary of purpose and/or changes:

This proposed constitutional amendment would enumerate a right in the people to "use or consume medical cannabis products, regardless of form[...]" Such right would be subject to "laws, rules, and regulations" governing the authority of medical professionals to recommend and dispense cannabis. Such laws, rules, and regulations would not be permissible unless they "preserve or facilitate" the right to use medical cannabis.

## Explanation of amendments:

The committee amendment amends the proposed constitutional amendment to remove ambiguous limiting language and replace it with a clear standard of review for courts to apply.
