Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 655 allows the Director of Administrative Services to permit a state employee, with the authorization of his or her supervisor, to participate in volunteer activities at a public elementary, middle, or high school, or a nonprofit organization that focuses on such education during normal work hours, without loss of pay, vacation time, sick leave, or earned overtime accumulation.

The Department of Administrative Services identifies a state-wide fiscal year 2017-18 cost of \$9,511,534. This is not a cost of expenditures, rather it represents the salaries and benefits that will be spent while employees are volunteering. The cost is more accurately identified as a lost productivity cost. The DAS estimate includes the following assumptions: 50% of employees participating for half of one work day per month. This amount is applied to the average state employee's average wage and benefit cost. There is no basis to disagree with this estimate.

The University of Nebraska estimates a productivity loss of approximately 54,000 hours per year. This translates to about 26 FTE per year. The University also notes that inclusion under the provisions of LB 655 "may not be appropriate given our separate personnel system."

The State College System would face the same productivity loss. The College System notes: "given the Board of Trustees' constitutional authority, its personnel are not subject to DAS Regulations."

Explanation of Estimate:							

LB655 provides an opportunity for State employees to volunteer time at schools or non-profit organizations that focus on education during work time. The DAS Director would be given the authority to adopt and promulgate rules and regulations as necessary.

The bill impacts all state agencies, the University of Nebraska, the state colleges and the Department of Education. Because DAS does not have access to the personnel costs of the University of Nebraska or the State Colleges, they were excluded from our cost analysis. If enacted today, we estimate the statewide cost as follows:

The expenditures expressed for FY2017-18 and FY2018-19 below were derived by taking the estimated 2016 cost in the table above and increasing it by 1% ($$9,511,534 \times 1.01 = $9,606,649$) and 1.5% ($$9,606,649 \times 1.015 = $9,750,749$) respectively. These costs represent wages and benefits paid to State employees for an estimated amount of time spent as a volunteer.

The allocation by fund type in the table below was determined by using the State's four year average (2013-2016) of PSL (Personal Service Limitation) expenditures.
