Explanation of Estimate:

LB 9 would establish the Radon Resistant New Construction Task Force, chaired by the chief medical officer of the Division of Public Health of the Department of Health and Human Services. The task force would develop and provide recommendations by April 15, 2018, which are intended to be used to establish statutory minimum standards for radon resistant new construction in the state.

The Department would be required to reimburse task force members for their actual and necessary expenses as provided in sections 81-1174 to 81-1177, estimated at \$2000 annually. The Radon program generates sufficient cash revenues to support this added expense.
