## **LEGISLATIVE BILL 267**

- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 71-468, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
 2016, is amended to read:

3 71-468 In order to prevent, detect, and control pneumonia and
4 influenza outbreaks in Nebraska:

5 (1) Each  $\tau$  each general acute hospital, and intermediate care facility, nursing facility, and skilled nursing facility shall annually, 6 7 beginning no later than October 1 and ending on the following April 1, offer onsite vaccinations for influenza and pneumococcal disease to all 8 9 residents and to all inpatients prior to discharge, pursuant to 10 procedures of the facility and in accordance with the recommendations of the advisory committee on immunization practices of the Centers for 11 Disease Control and Prevention of the United States Public Health Service 12 13 of the United States Department of Health and Human Services as the recommendations existed on January 1, 2017; and 2012. 14

(2) Each nursing facility and skilled nursing facility shall 15 16 annually, beginning no later than October 1 and ending on the following April 1, offer onsite vaccinations for influenza and pneumococcal disease 17 to all employees, residents, and inpatients, pursuant to procedures of 18 the facility and in accordance with the recommendations of the advisory 19 committee on immunization practices of the Centers for Disease Control 20 and Prevention of the United States Public Health Service of the United 21 States Department of Health and Human Services as the recommendations 22 existed on January 1, 2017. This section shall not apply in individual 23 24 cases when contraindicated or if a national shortage of the vaccine exists. Nothing in this section shall be construed to require any 25 facility listed in this section to cover the cost of a vaccination 26 provided pursuant to this section. 27
