2	79-1015.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, and section
3	77-3446, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2016; to change
4	provisions relating to the Tax Equity and Educational Opportunities
5	Support Act; to change the base limitation; to change the local
6	effort rate; to eliminate obsolete provisions; to repeal the
7	original sections; and to declare an emergency.

8 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 77-3446, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
 2016, is amended to read:

77-3446 Base limitation means the budget limitation rate applicable 3 to school districts and the limitation on growth of restricted funds 4 5 applicable to other political subdivisions prior to any increases in the rate as a result of special actions taken by a supermajority of any 6 7 governing board or of any exception allowed by law. The base limitation is two and one-half percent until adjusted, except that the base 8 9 limitation for school districts for school fiscal years 2017-18 and 10 2018-19 year 2012-13 is one-half of one percent and the base limitation for school districts for school fiscal year 2013-14 is zero one and one-11 half percent. The base limitation may be adjusted annually by the 12 Legislature to reflect changes in the prices of services and products 13 used by school districts and political subdivisions. 14

Sec. 2. Section 79-1015.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is amended to read:

17 79-1015.01 (1) Local system formula resources shall include local
18 effort rate yield which shall be computed as prescribed in this section.

(2) For each school fiscal year except school fiscal 2017-18 and 19 2018-19 years 2011-12 through 2013-14: (a) For state aid certified 20 pursuant to section 79-1022, the local effort rate shall be the maximum 21 levy, for the school fiscal year for which aid is being certified, 22 authorized pursuant to subdivision (2)(a) of section 77-3442 less five 23 24 cents; (b) for the final calculation of state aid pursuant to section 25 79-1065, the local effort rate shall be the rate which, when multiplied by the total adjusted valuation of all taxable property in local systems 26 receiving equalization aid pursuant to the Tax Equity and Educational 27 Opportunities Support Act, will produce the amount needed to support the 28 total formula need of such local systems when added to state aid 29 appropriated by the Legislature and other actual receipts of local 30 systems described in section 79-1018.01; and (c) the local effort rate 31

yield for such school fiscal years shall be determined by multiplying
 each local system's total adjusted valuation by the local effort rate.

3 (3) For school fiscal years 2011-12 and 2012-13: (a) For state aid 4 certified pursuant to section 79-1022, the local effort rate shall be the 5 maximum levy, for the school fiscal year for which aid is being 6 certified, authorized pursuant to subdivision (2)(a) of section 77-3442 7 less one and five-hundredths of one cent; (b) for the final calculation of state aid pursuant to section 79-1065, the local effort rate shall be 8 9 the rate which, when multiplied by the total adjusted valuation of all 10 taxable property in local systems receiving equalization aid pursuant to the Tax Equity and Educational Opportunities Support Act, will produce 11 12 the amount needed to support the total formula need of such local systems 13 when added to state aid appropriated by the Legislature and other actual receipts of local systems described in section 79-1018.01; and (c) the 14 15 local effort rate yield for such school fiscal years shall be determined by multiplying each local system's total adjusted valuation by the local 16 17 effort rate.

(3) (4) For school fiscal years 2017-18 and 2018-19 year 2013-14: 18 (a) For state aid certified pursuant to section 79-1022, the local effort 19 rate shall be the maximum levy, for the school fiscal year for which aid 20 is being certified, authorized pursuant to subdivision (2)(a) of section 21 22 77-3442 less four two cents; (b) for the final calculation of state aid pursuant to section 79-1065, the local effort rate shall be the rate 23 24 which, when multiplied by the total adjusted valuation of all taxable 25 property in local systems receiving equalization aid pursuant to the Tax Equity and Educational Opportunities Support Act, will produce the amount 26 27 needed to support the total formula need of such local systems when added to state aid appropriated by the Legislature and other actual receipts of 28 local systems described in section 79-1018.01; and (c) the local effort 29 rate yield for such school fiscal years shall be determined by 30 multiplying each local system's total adjusted valuation by the local 31

1 effort rate.

Nebraska, and section 77-3446, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
2016, are repealed.
