- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to offenses against animals; to amend section
- 2 28-101, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to provide immunity
- 3 from criminal or civil liability for removal of an animal from a
- 4 motor vehicle by forcible entry as prescribed; to provide a duty for
- 5 the Revisor of Statutes; and to repeal the original section.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 28-101, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 3 28-101 Sections 28-101 to 28-1357, 28-1418.01, 28-1429.03, and
- 4 28-1601 to 28-1603 and section 2 of this act shall be known and may be
- 5 cited as the Nebraska Criminal Code.
- 6 Sec. 2. (1) Any person who causes damage to a vehicle resulting
- 7 from forcible entry to remove and rescue an animal locked or trapped
- 8 inside the vehicle shall be immune from criminal or civil liability for
- 9 any damage to the vehicle if:
- 10 (a) The vehicle is locked or there is no other reasonable method by
- 11 which to extricate the animal than by forcible entry;
- 12 <u>(b) The person has a reasonable belief that forcible entry is</u>
- 13 <u>necessary because the animal is in imminent danger of suffering harm or</u>
- 14 death if not immediately removed from the vehicle based upon the
- 15 surrounding circumstances;
- 16 (c) The person has contacted either law enforcement, the fire
- 17 <u>department, an animal control agency, or an emergency 911 service</u>
- 18 operator prior to forcible entry of the vehicle;
- 19 (d) The person places a written notice securely on the windshield or
- 20 <u>driver's side door of the vehicle if a motor vehicle, or on the door or</u>
- 21 window where it will reasonably be found if any other vehicle, with the
- 22 person's name, telephone number, or other contact information along with
- 23 an explanation of why forcible entry was made, the location of the
- 24 animal, and the fact that authorities have been notified;
- 25 (e) The person remains with the animal in a safe location and
- 26 protected from the elements, but reasonably close to the location of the
- 27 <u>vehicle until such time as law enforcement, the fire department, animal</u>
- 28 control, or other emergency responder arrives; and
- 29 <u>(f) No more force than reasonably necessary was used to enter the</u>
- 30 <u>vehicle under the circumstances.</u>
- 31 (2) No person who attempts to administer further aid to an animal

1 <u>rescued in conformance with this section shall be subject to any criminal</u>

- 2 <u>or civil liability for harm or death to the animal.</u>
- 3 (3) Nothing in this section shall be construed to limit the
- 4 <u>liability of any person for death or injury caused to another person.</u>

- 6 to Chapter 28, article 10.

- 8 Nebraska, is repealed.
