## **LEGISLATIVE BILL 611**

Introduced by Stinner, 48.

Committee: Appropriations

- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to government; to amend section 81-132,
- 2 Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2016; to provide for a
- 3 federal funding inventory from each state agency; to harmonize
- 4 provisions; and to repeal the original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 81-132, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
- 2 2016, is amended to read:
- 3 81-132 (1) All departments, offices, institutions, and expending
- 4 agencies of the state government requesting appropriations for the next
- 5 biennium shall file in the office of the Director of Administrative
- 6 Services the budget forms furnished them by the director under the
- 7 provisions of sections 81-1113 and 81-1113.01 and the federal funding
- 8 inventory required by section 2 of this act. The <del>Such</del> budget forms shall
- 9 be filed on or before September 15 of each even-numbered year. The forms
- 10 shall show their total estimated requirements for the next biennium for
- 11 each unit of their organization and activity classified as to object of
- 12 expenditure. With such forms, each department, office, institution, and
- 13 expending agency shall file a report showing all money received by such
- 14 department, office, institution, or expending agency together with the
- 15 estimated receipts for the next biennium. Such estimates shall be
- 16 accompanied by a statement in writing giving facts and explanations of
- 17 reasons for each item of increased appropriation requested. The report
- 18 submitted by the Department of Health and Human Services shall include,
- 19 but not be limited to, the key goals, benchmarks, and progress reports
- 20 required pursuant to sections 81-3133 to 81-3133.03.
- 21 (2) Any department, office, institution, or expending agency
- 22 proposing changes to its appropriation for the biennium in progress shall
- 23 file in the office of the Director of Administrative Services the budget
- 24 forms for requesting such changes furnished by the director under the
- 25 provisions of sections 81-1113 and 81-1113.01. Such forms shall be filed
- on or before October 24 of each odd-numbered year.
- 27 Sec. 2. (1) The federal funding inventory shall be included with
- 28 the budget forms under subsection (1) of section 81-132 and submitted to
- 29 <u>the office of the Director of Administrative Services. The federal</u>
- 30 funding inventory shall include:
- 31 (a) The aggregate value of the federal receipts of the agency for

- 1 the preceding fiscal year;
- 2 <u>(b) The aggregate amount of federal funds appropriated to the agency</u>
- 3 by the Legislature for the preceding fiscal year;
- 4 (c) The percentage of the agency's total budget for the preceding
- 5 <u>fiscal year that constitutes federal receipts received by the agency for</u>
- 6 that fiscal year;
- 7 (d) Any requirement for a state match and a copy of any agreement,
- 8 <u>including a memorandum of understanding, a maintenance-of-effort</u>
- 9 agreement, or a contract, entered into with any federal agency or entity
- 10 <u>to receive federal receipts for the preceding fiscal year, with a cover</u>
- 11 <u>sheet that details the obligations imposed on the state agency, including</u>
- 12 <u>any state monetary match requirements, the number of full-time and part-</u>
- 13 <u>time positions obligated by the agreement, and a description of any other</u>
- 14 resources and obligations incurred by the state agency, and the citation
- 15 to the applicable federal law, regulation, or grant provision;
- 16 (e) An operating plan in the event that the federal receipts are
- 17 reduced by ten percent or more but less than twenty-five percent from the
- 18 preceding fiscal year;
- 19 <u>(f) An operating plan in the event that the federal receipts are</u>
- 20 reduced by twenty-five percent or more from the preceding fiscal year;
- 21 (g) A detailed description of the actions or results that were
- 22 promised by the state agency in order to receive the federal receipts;
- 23 (h) The state statutory objective that is being met by accepting the
- 24 <u>federal receipts; and</u>
- 25 (i) A detailed list of federal receipts that have a foreseeable or
- 26 potential end date, the date, and the schedule of federal receipts
- 27 <u>expected until that date.</u>
- 28 (2) For purposes of this section, federal receipts means any
- 29 <u>financial assistance received from the United States Government or any</u>
- 30 agency thereof whether by contract, grant subsidy, augmentation, or
- 31 reimbursement or by any other form.
