The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

Currently it is not possible for mobile hair salons to operate in Nebraska. Current statutes have not accounted for technological developments that now make such businesses feasible. LB790 would update statutes with parameters to allow these businesses to operate. There are cosmetologists and hair dressers who wish to serve clients outside their established stationary location. These clients include those who are home-bound; in nursing facilities; without reliable transportation; and those clients who live a great distance away but the client and hair dresser would like to continue their established business relationship. LB790 establishes reasonable requirements for these mobile businesses to operate in Nebraska by addressing safety concerns and similar licensing credentials stationary businesses of the same type must comply with.
