Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 468 amends the Medical Assistance Act.

It inserts a new section which prohibits any new service or population from being added into Medicaid managed care, at least until January 1, 2020 or until an evaluation of managed care is performed or the success of managed care is demonstrated. (Sec. 2.)

Explanation of amendments:

AM 1166 amends the original provisions of LB 468 and adds a provision from LB 328.

LB 468 is amended so that long term care services and supports, including skilled nursing facilities, nursing facilities, assisted-living facilities, and home and community based services, may not be added into the Medicaid managed care program before July 1, 2021. (AM 1166, sec. 7, p. 3, lines 19-23.)

LB 328 (Bolz) Adopt the Nebraska Family First Act, provide for non-court involved response to report of child abuse or neglect, and provide for a family finding project.

AM 1166 incorporates the family finding project portion of LB 328 into LB 468. The family finding project was a pilot project with a sunset date of June 30, 2019. AM 1166 incorporates the provisions from LB 328 that remove the sunset and pilot project status of the family finding program. The sunset for the family finding program is struck in section 3 (sec. 3, p. 2, lines 18-19), and references to the pilot project are struck in several other sections (sec. 1(6), sec. 2, sec. 3, and sec. 4.)
