Summary of purpose and/or changes:

This bill would mandate the inclusion of the former Nebraska Veterans' Memorial Cemetery in Grand Island to the state veteran cemetery system administered by the Director of Veterans' Affairs. It states legislative intent that the director of the Department of Administrative Services negotiate with the City of Grand Island for acquisition of title to the cemetery and the land adjacent to it. It also directs the Veterans' Affairs director to prepare initial program materials and make an initial request for funding by September 15, 2020.

This bill also makes harmonizing changes to the statutory powers of a city of the first class to sell and convey real estate. Finally, the bill also includes revisor's changes to eliminate reference to fund transfers that have already been completed.
