1 Section 1. Section 60-3,191, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,

- 2 2018, is amended to read:
- 3 60-3,191 In addition to any other fee required under the Motor
- 4 Vehicle Registration Act, a fee for registration of each motor vehicle
- 5 powered by an alternative fuel shall be charged. The fee shall be
- 6 seventy-five dollars for each such motor vehicle registered in 2019,
- 7 eighty-five dollars for 2020, ninety-five dollars for 2021, one hundred
- 8 five dollars for 2022, one hundred fifteen dollars for 2023, and one
- 9 <u>hundred twenty-five dollars for 2024 and every year thereafter</u>. The fee
- 10 shall be collected by the county treasurer and remitted to the State
- 11 Treasurer for credit to the Highway Trust Fund.
