- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1	Section 1. <u>There is hereby appropriated \$37,000,000 from Federal</u>
2	Funds for FY2021-22 to the Department of Health and Human Services, for
3	Program 424, Developmental Disability Aid. The Federal Funds appropriated
4	in this section are from the funds allocated to the State of Nebraska
5	from the federal Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund pursuant to the
6	<u>federal American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, Public Law 117-2, Subtitle M,</u>
7	<u>Sec. 9901.</u>
8	There is included in the appropriation to this program for FY2021-22
9	<u>\$37,000,000 Federal Funds for state aid, which shall only be used for</u>
10	such purpose.
11	No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems
12	for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated in this
13	<u>section.</u>
14	There is included in the appropriation for this program for
15	FY2021-22 \$37,000,000 for rate increases for agency providers for the
16	following services, which shall only be used for such purpose:
17	Prevocational; Residential Habilitation, excluding Shared Living
18	<u>Services; Supported Employment – Individual; Enclave; Behavioral In-Home</u>
19	Habilitation; Community Inclusion; Community Integration; Consultative
20	Assessment; Crisis Intervention Support; Habilitative Workshop;
21	Independent Living; In-Home Residential Habilitation; Medical In-Home
22	<u>Habilitation; Supported Family Living; Supported Employment – Follow</u>
23	Along; and Child Day Habilitation.
24	Sec. 2. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when

25 passed and approved according to law.
