- 4 known and may be cited as the Election Act.
- 5 Sec. 2. (1) Any election conducted pursuant to the Election Act
- 6 shall be funded only by an appropriation from the federal government, the
- 7 State of Nebraska, a political subdivision, or a combination of such
- 8 sources. The Secretary of State, election commissioners, and county
- 9 clerks shall not solicit, accept, or use any grants or donations from any
- 10 private entity for preparing for, administering, or conducting an
- 11 election.
- 12 (2) This section does not prohibit (a) the acceptance of an in-kind
- 13 contribution of food or beverages for election workers during the
- 14 <u>administration of an election or (b) the actual use of a public or</u>
- 15 private building, without charge or for a reduced fee, for the purposes
- 16 of conducting an election, including use as a polling place or for
- 17 election training purposes.
