Summary of purpose and/or changes:

Nebraska Revised Statute § 40-101 currently exempts homesteads valued at \$60,000 or less from judgment liens and forced sales except as otherwise provided in Chapter 40.

LB1268 increases the value of exempt homesteads from \$60,000 to \$120,000 and provides that the exemption only applies to natural persons residing in the state.
