Summary of purpose and/or changes:

Section 4 would amend 81-1401 to define "eligible immigrant" as a person that has been formally granted and maintains Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals status by the United States Citizen and Immigration Services.

Section 1 would amend 4-108 to allow eligible immigrants employed as a law enforcement officer to participate in a state retirement system.

Section 2 would amend 4-111 to allow eligible immigrants to verify lawful presence in the United States for purposes of attending a law enforcement training academy and employment as a law enforcement officer.

Section 3 would amend 23-2306 to allow an eligible immigrant employed as a law enforcement officer to participate in the County Employees Retirement plan.

Section 5 would amend 81-1410 to expand the definition of applicant to a law enforcement training academy to include eligible immigrants.

Section 6 would amend 81-2016 to allow eligible immigrants employed as a law enforcement officer to participate in the Nebraska State Patrol Retirement plan.

Section 7 would amend 84-1307 to allow eligible immigrants employed as a law enforcement officer to participate in the state employees retirement plan.

Section 8 would amend 84-1504 to allow eligible immigrants employed as a law enforcement officer to participate in the state deferred compensation plan.
