- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to days of observance; to declare October 17
- 2 as Nebraska Missing Persons Day and May 19 as El-Hajj Malik El-
- 3 Shabazz, Malcolm X Day.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. October 17 of each year shall be recognized as Nebraska
- 2 <u>Missing Persons Day. Nebraska Missing Persons Day is observed not only</u>
- 3 for the missing people, but also for their families and friends who deal
- 4 with the trauma of having their loved one go missing without a trace.
- 5 This day respects and honors their grief.
- 6 Sec. 2. May 19 of each year shall be recognized as El-Hajj Malik
- 7 <u>El-Shabazz, Malcolm X Day, and shall be set apart for holding suitable</u>
- 8 exercises in the schools of the state in recognition of the sacrifices of
- 9 the late Nebraska Hall of Fame inductee El-Hajj Malik El-Shabazz, Malcolm
- 10 X and his contributions to the betterment of society.
