- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to animals; to amend section 71-4408, Reissue
- 2 Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to require and restrict certain
- 3 actions of any animal control facility, animal rescue, animal
- 4 shelter, or rabies control authority; to harmonize provisions; and
- 5 to repeal the original section.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. (1) For purposes of this section, animal control entity

- 2 <u>means any:</u>
- 3 (a) Animal control facility as defined in section 54-626;
- 4 (b) Animal rescue as defined in section 54-626;
- 5 <u>(c) Animal shelter as defined in section 54-626; and</u>
- 6 (d) Rabies control authority as defined in section 71-4401.
- 7 (2) Any animal control entity that captures or receives any animal
- 8 <u>shall within seventy-two hours of capturing or receiving such animal:</u>
- 9 (a) Make a reasonable attempt to identify the owner of such animal;
- 10 (b) If the animal control entity determines the identity of the
- 11 <u>owner of such animal, attempt to contact such owner via each of the</u>
- 12 following methods:
- (i) Regular United States mail, if such owner's mailing address is
- 14 known;
- 15 (ii) Telephone, if such owner's telephone number is known; and
- 16 (iii) Electronic mail, if such owner's email address is known; and
- 17 (c) If the animal control entity cannot determine the identity of
- 18 the owner of such animal or determines the identity of the owner but
- 19 <u>fails to contact the owner, post a photograph of such animal on the</u>
- 20 <u>website of the animal control entity.</u>
- 21 (3) No animal control entity shall put up for adoption, sell, or
- 22 dispose of any animal until after a photograph has been posted on the
- 23 website of such animal control entity for at least ten days.
- Sec. 2. Section 71-4408, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 25 amended to read:
- 26 71-4408 (1) The rabies control authority may authorize an animal
- 27 pound or pounds or may enter into a cooperative agreement with a licensed
- 28 veterinarian for the establishment and operation of a pound.
- 29 (2) Any dog or hybrid of the family Canidae found outside the
- 30 owner's premises whose owner does not possess a valid certificate of
- 31 rabies vaccination and valid rabies vaccination tag for such dog or

- 1 hybrid of the family Canidae shall be impounded. The rabies control
- 2 authority may require the impoundment of domestic or hybrid animals other
- 3 than dogs or hybrids of the family Canidae. All impounded domestic or
- 4 hybrid animals shall be given proper care, treatment, and maintenance.
- 5 Each impounded domestic or hybrid animal shall be kept and maintained at
- 6 the pound for a period of not less than ten days seventy-two hours unless
- 7 reclaimed earlier by the owner.
- 8 (3) Notice of impoundment of all animals, including any significant
- 9 marks of identification, shall be posted at the pound as public
- 10 notification of impoundment. Any unvaccinated domestic or hybrid animal
- 11 may be reclaimed by its owner during the period of impoundment by payment
- 12 of prescribed pound fees and by complying with the rabies vaccination
- 13 requirement of sections 71-4401 to 71-4412 within seventy-two hours of
- 14 release. Any vaccinated domestic or hybrid animal impounded because its
- 15 owner has not presented a valid certificate of rabies vaccination and a
- 16 valid rabies vaccination tag for such domestic or hybrid animal may be
- 17 reclaimed by its owner by furnishing proof of rabies vaccination and
- 18 payment of all impoundment fees prior to release.
- 19 (4) At the expiration of impoundment, a domestic or hybrid animal
- 20 may be claimed by payment of established pound fees and by compliance
- 21 with the rabies vaccination requirement of sections 71-4401 to 71-4412
- 22 within seventy-two hours of release. After complying with section 1 of
- 23 this act, if If the domestic or hybrid animal is unclaimed at the end of
- 24 five days, the authorities may dispose of the domestic or hybrid animal
- 25 in accordance with applicable laws or rules and regulations.
- 26 Sec. 3. Original section 71-4408, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 27 Nebraska, is repealed.
