Section 81-2601, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
 2022, is amended to read:

81-2601 (1) There is hereby established the Commission on African
American Affairs. For purposes of sections 81-2601 to 81-2607, commission
means the Commission on African American Affairs.

6 (2) The commission shall consist of <u>nine</u> fourteen members who shall 7 be of African ancestry. Members of the commission shall be appointed by 8 the Governor. The commission may have such nonvoting, ex officio members 9 as shall be appointed by the commission and who need not be of African 10 ancestry. The commission shall elect one of its members as chairperson. <u>A</u> 11 <u>quorum shall be a majority of the members of the commission</u>.

(3) Members of the commission shall serve four-year terms or for the 12 13 unexpired term in the event of a vacancy. As the terms of the voting members expire, their successors shall be appointed by the Governor from 14 a panel of nominees submitted by the public. An appointment for an 15 16 unexpired term shall follow the same procedure as for initial and 17 subsequent appointments. Voting members shall be eligible for 18 reappointment.
