- A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to treatment and corrections; to amend sections 16-252, 17-566, 47-105, 47-105.01, 47-117, and 47-120, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to provide that the Department of Correctional Services shall operate the county jails; to provide a duty for the Judiciary Committee of the Legislature; to harmonize provisions; to provide an operative date; and to repeal the original sections.
- 8 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 16-252, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 2 amended to read:
- 3 16-252 Any city of the first class shall have the right to use the
- 4 jail of the county for the confinement of such persons as may be
- 5 imprisoned under the ordinances of such city. The city shall be liable to
- 6 the Department of Correctional Services county for the cost of keeping
- 7 such prisoners as provided by section 47-120.
- 8 Sec. 2. Section 17-566, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 9 amended to read:
- 10 17-566 Any city of the second class or village shall have the right
- 11 to use the county jail in the county in which the city or village is
- 12 located for the confinement of such persons as may be imprisoned under
- 13 the ordinances of such city or village. The city or village shall be
- 14 liable to the <u>Department of Correctional Services</u> county for the cost of
- 15 keeping such prisoners as provided by section 47-120.
- 16 Sec. 3. Section 47-105, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 18 47-105 The <u>Department of Correctional Services</u> sheriff, or, in case
- 19 of his or her death, removal, or disability, the person by law appointed
- 20 to such office, shall have charge of each the county jail of his or her
- 21 proper county, and of all persons by law confined therein, and the
- 22 department such sheriff or other person as may be charged with the
- 23 administration of the jail shall conform to the rules and directions of
- 24 the Jail Standards Board which may be made and communicated to him or her
- 25 by the county board.
- Sec. 4. Section 47-105.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 28 47-105.01 The <u>Department of Correctional Services sheriff or such</u>
- 29 other person as may be charged with the administration of the jail shall
- 30 conform to the rules and directions as prescribed by the Jail Standards
- 31 Board pursuant to sections 47-101 and 47-104 which may be made and

- 1 communicated to him or her by the county board.
- Sec. 5. Section 47-117, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 3 amended to read:
- 4 47-117 For the purposes of Chapter 47, article 1, jail shall be
- 5 defined to include a jail, house of correction, community residential
- 6 center, work release center, halfway house, or other place of confinement
- 7 of a person committed by any lawful authority to any suitable and
- 8 appropriate residence, facility, center, or institution designated as a
- 9 jail facility by the county or the Department of Correctional Services.
- Sec. 6. Section 47-120, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 11 amended to read:
- 12 47-120 The <u>Department of Correctional Services</u> county board or
- 13 county board of corrections serving pursuant to Chapter 23, article 28,
- 14 shall provide proper quarters and adequate equipment for the preparation
- 15 and serving of all meals furnished to all prisoners confined in the
- 16 county jail. The <u>department</u> county sheriff or the county board of
- 17 corrections shall have full charge and control of such services and the
- 18 county board shall provide for all washing, fuel, lights, and clothing
- 19 for prisoners, subject to the right of the <u>department</u> county to be paid
- 20 by the city or federal government for city or federal prisoners at actual
- 21 cost to the <u>department</u> county. Supplies of every nature entering into the
- 22 furnishing of meals, washing, fuel, lights, and clothing to the prisoners
- 23 confined in the county jail shall be purchased and provided by the
- 24 <u>department</u> under the direction of the county sheriff or the county board
- 25 of corrections. Payment for all purchases shall only be made by the
- 26 county board on the original invoices submitted by the sheriff or the
- 27 county board of corrections of goods, supplies, and services, setting
- 28 forth (1) that the invoice correctly describes the goods as to quality
- 29 and quantity, (2) that the same have been received and are in the custody
- 30 of the affiant, (3) that they have been or will be devoted exclusively to
- 31 the purposes authorized in this section, and (4) that the price charged

- 1 is reasonable and just. Nothing in this section shall be construed to
- 2 restrict the sheriff or the county board of corrections in employing
- 3 necessary personnel and from otherwise carrying out the duties required
- 4 in the operation of the jail.
- 5 Sec. 7. The Judiciary Committee of the Legislature shall prepare an
- 6 <u>amendment to harmonize provisions of state law consistent with this act.</u>
- 7 Sec. 8. This act becomes operative on July 1, 2025.
- 8 Sec. 9. Original sections 16-252, 17-566, 47-105, 47-105.01,
- 9 47-117, and 47-120, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, are repealed.
