LEGISLATIVE BILL 161

Approved by the Governor March 16, 1971

Introduced by Ernest Chambers, 11th District

AN ACT relating to cities and villages, all; to authorize ordinances to prevent discrimination in public accommodations; to provide for enforcement and penalties for violations.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Notwithstanding any other law or laws heretofore enacted, all cities and villages in this state shall have the power by ordinance to define, regulate, suppress and prevent discrimination on the basis of race, color, creed, religion, ancestry, sex, or national origin in employment and in public accommodation and may provide for the enforcement of such ordinances by providing appropriate penalties for the violation thereof.
