## LEGISLATIVE BILL 560

Approved by the Governor May 20, 1971

Introduced by Donald Elrod, 35th District

AN ACT to amend section 51-210, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, relating to municipal libraries; to increase the power of eminent domain by the library board as prescribed; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 51-210, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

51-210. Every library board created under the provisions of sections 51-201 to 51-219, --inclusive, shall have power to purchase or lease grounds, to exercise the power of eminent domain and to condemn real estate, -except--such--as--may--be--already--occupied--by permanent-structures--for--business--purposes, for the purpose of securing a site for a library building. The procedure to condemn property shall be exercised in the manner set forth in sections 76-704 to 76-724.

Sec. 2. That original section 51-210, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
