- AN ACT to amend section 83-905, Revised Statutes
  Supplement, 1973, relating to public
  institutions; to change the name of the State
  Reformatory for Women as prescribed; to
  harmonize with other legislation; to provide
  duties for the Revisor of Statutes; and to
  repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 83-905, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1973, be amended to read as follows:

83-905. The official names of the state institutions under the supervision of the Department of Correctional Services shall be as follows: (1) Netraska Penal and Correctional Complex, (2) Youth Development Center-Kearney, (3) Youth Development Center-Geneva, (4) State-Reformatory-for-Women Netraska Center for Homen, and (5) Youth Diagnostic and Rehabilitation Center.

- Sec. 2. Whenever the term State Reformatory for Momen appears in the statutes, it shall, after the effective date of this act, be construed to mean and apply to the Netraska Center for Women, and the Revisor of Statutes shall make the appropriate changes in the statutes. The sections in which such term appears are sections 28-411, 29-908, 83-171, 83-176, and 83-227.02.
- Sec. 3. That original section 83-905, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1973, is repealed.
