SPEAKER: Any further discussion of the bill. The question is shall LB 1 be advanced from General File to E & R Initial. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Voting on the advancement of LB 1 to E & R Initial. Senator Hasebroock voting aye. Again the chair would inquire if you have all voted? The clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 37 ayes, Mr. President, on motion to advance.

SPEAKER: Bill is advanced. The chair recognizes Senator Barnett. For what purpose do you rise, Senator?

SENATOR BARNETT: Mr. President, I would like to ask you a question. Is there any way we can expedite the purchase or the handing out of these books that will be the responsibility of the clerk.

CLERK: The clerk's observed and the chair would likewise observe that we have to get the bill adopted first here through the normal procedures.

SPEAKER: Senator, I am sure the clerk's office expedites everything.

SENATOR BARNETT: That's why I asked the question.

SPEAKER: Ready for the General File consideration of LB 2.

CLERK: Read Title. LB 2. There are no amendments.

SPEAKER: The chair recognizes Senator Luedtke.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Mr. President, I move that LB 2 be advanced to E & R Initial. Mr. President, members of the Legislature, again the same type of a Revisors Bill which merely in Sub-section 2 of Section 48-434 eliminates reference to Justice of the Peace, Police Magistrate and other Magistrates pursuant to LB 1032 of the last session.

SPEAKER: Any further discussion of the bill? The question is shall LB 2 be advanced from General File to E & R Initial. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no.

CLERK: Senator Hasebroock voting aye.

SPEAKER: Have you all voted? The clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER: The bill is advanced. We are ready for the General File consideration of LB 3. The clerk will read the title.

CLERK: Read title. LB 3. Read.

SPEAKER: The chair recognizes Senator Luedtke.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: I move the bill LB 3 be advanced to E & R Initial. Mr. President, members of the Legislature, right here is an example of why we need these statutes books on our desk or in the vicinity of our desk because if any of you know by road memory what 45401 to 45407 means unless you tried the cases in the Supreme Court, I seriously doubt. In other words, these particular sections were declared unconstitutional by the Supreme Court of the State of Nebraska in the case of Davis versus General Motors Acceptance Corporation and unless you have the statutes before you, you wouldn't know that and this is the reason that they were asked to be repealed and taken off the books.
