SPEAKER: The Chair recognizes Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: What this whole bill does is only brings in to designation of the change in the wording of the committees which was changed in some extent in the session we had on December the 3rd. As an illustration we increased the, changed the name of the recreation to, changed the word budget for example to appropriation, it's just a procedural thing in order to change the designation as it did exist with the change which we approved December the 5th. And I move for adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER: Is there any further discussion of Senator Carpenter's amendment to LB 81? Any discussion? The question is shall the amendment be adopted? All those in favor say aye, those opposed say no. The amendment is adopted. Senator Carpenter the bill is amended.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I move the bill as amended be advanced to E & R for initial.

SPEAKER: Is there any further discussion of LB 81 as amended. Question is shall LB 81 as amended be advanced from general file to E & R initial. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no.

CLERK: Senator Hasebroock voting aye, Senator Fellman voting aye.

SPEAKER: Once again have you all voted? The clerk will record the votes.

CLERK: 40 ayes Mr. President, no nays, 9 not voting.

SPEAKER: The bill is amended as advanced. Ready for the general file consideration of LB 82. The clerk will read the title.

CLERK: Title read LB 82.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I move that LB 82 be advanced to E & R for initial. Now the purpose of this bill is that the present law precludes the clerk and the assistant clerk from being paid overtime. We strike that provision out and we leave it up to the body upon the recommendation of the executive council to either pay the clerk or the assistant clerk or (inaudible) give them off setting time. I move the bill be advanced.

SPEAKER: Any further discussion of the bill? Question is shall LB 82 be advanced from general file to E & R initial, all those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no.

CLERK: Senator Hasebroock voting aye, Senator Fellman voting aye.

SPEAKER: Once again have you all voted? Voting on the advancement of LB 82 from general file. The clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 34 ayes, no nays Mr. President, remainder not voting.

SPEAKER: The bill is advanced. Ready for the general file consideration of LB 83. The clerk will read the title.

CLERK: Title read LB 83.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Mr. President I move an amendment on line 13 to strike the word 10, 5 which is new matter and insert the 2.
