I hate to see us wasting days of the 90 day session for two and three minute, er twenty minute times and consequently this thought, and I'm not an advocator of adjourning until Monday, but I think we'd better recess here for say five, ten, fifteen minutes to give a little thought to this situation and maybe the speaker could get together with the head of the Executive Council and a few others and figure out whether or not we're wasting time or not or wasting days by meeting without business. So if I might amend, I guess I can't amend the motion to adjourn, I'm sorry but, if I can I would say I would move to amend the motion to recess for fifteen minutes.

SPEAKER: The Chair would accept that, Senator Keyes.

SENATOR KEYES: Mr. President, I would whoever put these head-rests on the chairs to come on the back of the chair, and make sure that that screw is filed off so that it doesn't catch, it just caught my coat and tore it, and I prize my clothes very highly.

CLERK: Mr. President we have a notice of hearing submitted by the revenue committee, signed Senator Burbach.

SPEAKER: The Chair recognizes Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, the members of the Government Committee, we were going to meet at 1:45, but if we adjourn early, then right after we adjourn could you come to this chair and then we'll decide what we are going to do, it won't take long. Thank you.

SPEAKER: Let's consider the - just a minute, fine. We can move to the general file consideration of LB 5 and 7. Senator Simpson has prepared to present these. We'll hold off on the motion to recess for just a little bit. Very good,

CLERK: Mr. President we also have a notice of a Committee Hearing the Appropriations Committee will meet in 1003 at 2:00 today, signed Senator Marvel. Mr. President we have one new bill LB 161 Title Read. That's all Mr. President.

SPEAKER: Thank you, if we could restore a little bit of order at this time we will have the general file consideration of LB 5.

CLERK: Title Read LB 5. Amendment read.

SPEAKER: The Chair recognizes Senator Goodrich.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Are we going to take up this bill even though Senator Luedtke is not here?

SPEAKER: That is correct sir.
