CLERK: Yes.

SPEAKER: Motion is to adopt the amendments, E & R amendments to LB 1. All those in favor of the motion signify by saying aye, those opposed say no. So ordered, the amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, there is a unanimous consent amendment to amend LB 1 - Read.

SPEAKER: The chair recognizes Senator Carpenter. Senator Carpenter, we have your unanimous consent motion on LB 1.

I would like to respectfully ask at that time to drop your conversations or at least hold them down to a roar.
