SPEAKER: Are there any objections to the withdrawal of that bill? If not, it is withdrawn. Anything further on the clerk's desk.

CLERK: Mr. President, an explanation of vote. Read. Mr. President, I move to place LB 85 on General File notwithstanding the action of the committee. Signed, Senator Mahoney.

SPEAKER: Senator Mahoney. Is Senator Mahoney in the chamber? Senator Mahoney, did you want to lay that request over?

SENATOR MAHONEY: Mr. Speaker, yes I did that for Senator Carpenter who is out of the city. At the time he returns he can either decide to take it up or not.

SPEAKER: So then I believe your motion will be taken up later now that you--have made it.

SENATOR MAHONEY: Yes.

SPEAKER: Is that your understanding, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Yes sir.

SPEAKER: Is there anything else on the clerk's desk?

CLERK: That's all, Mr. President.

SPEAKER: We are then ready to go to Select File.

CLERK: Yes.

SPEAKER: The first bill on Select File is LB 140. Senator Cavanaugh.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move that the amendments to LB 140 be adopted.

SPEAKER: It has been moved and seconded that the amendments to LB 140 be adopted. All those in favor say aye, those opposed no. The amendments stand adopted.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move that LB 140 be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER: It has been moved and seconded that the bill be advanced to E & R for engrossment. Is there any discussion? All those in favor of advancing the bill say aye, those opposed no. The bill stands advanced.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the amendments to LB 56.

SPEAKER: Moved and seconded that the amendments be adopted to LB--that the E & R amendments to LB 56. Is there is no discussion all those in favor say aye, those opposed no. The amendments stand adopted. What will you do with the bill, Senator.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move that LB 56 as amended be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER: It has been moved and seconded that the bill be advanced to # & R for engrossment. All those in favor say aye, those opposed no. The bill is advanced.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move that the--the adoption of amendments to LB--E & R amendments to LB 142.

SPEAKER: It has moved that the E & R amendments to LB 142 be adopted. Is there any discussion? All those in favor say aye, those opposed no. The amendments are adopted.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move that LB 142 be advanced to E & R for engrossment.
