SPEAKER: Thank you. Is there any further discussion of the committee amendments. The question is--Senator Nore.

SENATOR NORE: Mr. President, I would like to ask Senator Warner a question.

SPEAKER: Senator Warner, will you yield to a question? Senator Nore, please pull your microphone clear over in front of you, sir. Will you?

SENATOR NORE: I don't know, Senator Warner, whether I understand this bill. I haven't read the bill but we have had some difficulty with the Secretary. Who is the Secretary of the Board of Trustees now?

SENATOR WARNER: Dr. Todd at the present time.

SENATOR NORE: Whom?

SENATOR WARNER: Dr. Todd, I believe.

SENATOR NORE: Yes. We understand the morale of the Administrative folks in the State Colleges has been going down and down because--now we are doing something that will probably increase the morale,--that is, decrease the morale of our State Colleges. I think that each College should operate as economically as possible and operate more efficiently and fit their needs much better, so personally I am opposed to this particular piece of legislation.

SENATOR WARNER: Senator Nore, I did not explain the content of the bill, Senator Stromer's bill, which I assume he will do. I only mentioned the committee amendment so I would yield to Senator Stromer if you wish to get into the content or purpose of the bill other than committee amendment.

SPEAKER: Any further discussion of the committee amendments. Senator Stromer, did you wish to be recognized. Senator Nore, would you turn off your little light, please? Any further discussion of the committee amendments? All those in favor of the Warner committee amendments--excuse me, all those in favor of the committee amendments as explained by Senator Warner say aye, those opposed say no. So ordered, the amendments are adopted. Are there other amendments to LB 130.

CLERK: None, Mr. President.

SPEAKER: Back to Senator Stromer:

SENATOR STROMER: Mr. President, and fellow members, LB 130 as amended. All it does is take away the requirement that the State Board of Trustees must have their office in the Capitol Building. Also, the second part, all it refers to is to the fact that they must keep their vouchers so it strikes this part from the law, also. Both of these are due to a matter of space problem that we have here in the Capitol which I think we are all very much aware of and so for this reason this is why the bill has been introduced and this is the present form that we are talking about and I think the comment that Senator Nore was referring to--anything there has been amended out, Senator Nore, so that we are not referring to that part any more. All we're referring to is the Board office and the vouchers and I might mention with the vouchers, already they are required to be on file at two other places with state agencies and are a matter of public record and so all we are doing is being redundant in keeping vouchers on file which really are unnecessary. I move that LB 130 be moved to E & R Initial as amended.

SPEAKER: Is there any further discussion of the bill? The question is shall LB 94, excuse me, shall LB 130 be advanced as amended from General File to E & R, Initial. All those in
