CLERK: Read title. LB 377

That is all, Mr. President.

SPEAKER: We are ready for the consideration of bills on Select File. Senator Cavanaugh, what is your pleasure?

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the amendments to LB 52.

SPEAKER: There is a motion to adopt the amendments to LB 52 on Select File. Is there need for discussion. All those in favor of adopting the amendments, please say aye, those opposed say no. So ordered, the amendments are adopted.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 52 as amended to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER: The motion to advance LB 52 as amended. All those in favor of the motion please say aye, those opposed say no. So ordered, LB 52 as amended is advanced.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 69 to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER: There is a motion to advance LB 69. Is there need for discussion. The chair recognizes Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I would like to ask Senator Snyder a question.

SPEAKER: I don't think the Senator is here today, Senator.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I'd like to have the bill passed though with this explanation. When this bill was passed in its original form, at least part of the reason it was passed at that time was that these people would be elected after they were first appointed. Now I want to know why some method of information why this change is necessary to now continue their appointment without an election. This Omaha transit authority is a highly important thing and I don't think it should be made the whim of those people who probably have the ability to appoint in the future. I think we are going to have a lot of money over there, we are going to have a lot of responsibility and transportation is an important thing. And I think it ought to be kept in the hands of the people and not in the hands of which this bill apparently require them to appoint who they desire. For that reason, I ask the bill to be passed over.

SPEAKER: Are there any objections to passing over LB 69 at this time? Just a minute, let me dispatch. Are there any objections. If there are none, so ordered. The bill is then passed over. Excuse me, (inaudible), did you object. Thank you. Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I ask unanimous consent to unbracket 93 and let it be put at the bottom of Select File and be in advance this morning.

SPEAKER: Senator Carpenter is asking unanimous consent to unbracket 93 and put it on the bottom of Select File for consideration. Are there objections to that motion? Do you need more time to consider the motion? Senator Carstena, are you objecting. If there are no objections, so ordered. Move 93 to the bottom of Select File. We are then back to you Senator Cavanaugh on LB 101.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 101.
