SPEAKER: You've heard the motion and the support. Is there any need for further discussion. All those in favor of advancing LB 200 as amended from General File to E & R, Initial vote aye, all those opposed vote no. The clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 0 nays, 16 not voting, Mr. President, on the motion to advance.

SPEAKER: LB 200 as amended is advanced. Next take up the General File consideration of LB 35. The chair recognizes Senator Maresh.

SENATOR MARESH: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, Senator Keyes is not here. LB 35 is Senator Keyes' bill. I ask unanimous consent to pass over LB 35.

SPEAKER: A motion to pass over LB 35. Are there any objections. There are none, so ordered. The bill is passed over and we will move on to the General File consideration of LB 88.

SPEAKER: Mr. Speaker, would you come forward please?

CLERK: Read title. LB 88. There are no committee amendments or other amendments.

SPEAKER: Senator Wiltse. Senator, I don't believe your microphone is turned on.

SENATOR WILTSE: This is nothing but a correction bill and as to further information on it I'd like to refer it to Senator Duis since he has a little more on it.

SPEAKER: Is Senator Duis in the chamber?

SENATOR DUIS: Yes. Yes, what was it.

SPEAKER: Senator Wiltse, would you repeat your question. Senator Duis is at his desk now.

SENATOR WILTSE: As I said, LB 88 is nothing but a correction bill and if there is anything further that you wish to make as a comment on it, we'd appreciate it.

SENATOR DUIS: Thank you, Senator Wiltse. Let me say that the reason for LB 88 is that there are two statutes which are in conflict. One puts the responsibility of these bridges with the county, the other puts the responsibility of the bridges with the Public Power Irrigation and Drainage District which ever it may be or an absolute conflict. And so by cancelling both of them, we avoid the conflict and that is the reason for the bill.

SPEAKER: Is there any further discussion of the bill. You haven't moved, Senator, have you to advance the bill. It's been moved and seconded that the bill be advanced, so are you ready for the question. All those in favor vote yes, all opposed vote no. Have you all voted? The clerk will record.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays, 18 not voting.

SPEAKER: Senator Duis. Senator Fellman. Senator Fellman voting aye. Senator Duis voting aye. I believe that brings up LB 90 by the Public Works Committee. Senator Stull's bill. Are you ready? The clerk will read LB 90.

CLERK: Read title. LB 90. There are committee amendments by Senator Kremer's Public Works Committee.

SPEAKER: Senator Kremer.

SENATOR KREMER: Mr. Chairman, I move that the committee amendments be adopted. What we are doing here, this bill
