SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President and members of the legislature, I move that LB 12 as amended be advanced to E&R initial.

SPEAKER: Stand tight, we apparently have another motion.

CLERK: I have a motion ahead of that Mr. President, I move to bracket LB 12 for one week, signed Senator Goodrich.

SPEAKER: Senator Goodrich.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Mr. President and members of the body. I had stated earlier that I was going to deliver a resolution to this body signed by all seven members of the city council and the Mayor of the city of Omaha, and I would ask that this bill be bracketed, I would move that this bill be bracketed for one week and get us a chance to get that and deliver it to each and every member of this body.

SPEAKER: You've heard the motion to bracket it, is there need for further discussion? Senator Mahoney did you wish to be recognized to speak on the motion to bracket? Senator Chambers do you want to speak on the motion? The question is shall the bill be bracketed, all those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. The motion before us is to bracket the bill for a week, have you all voted, once again the Chair would ask if you have all voted? I think the Chair in this instance before we announce the vote on this would rule that in order for you to bind the body and to hold this bill for a week it will take 25 votes. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 11 ayes, 24 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER: The motion to bracket fails. We are now back to Senator Chambers, are there any other motions on the bill?

CLERK: None.

SPEAKER: We are now back to Senator Chambers motion then to advance the bill as amended. Question is shall LB 12 as amended be advanced from general file to E&R initial. Senator Chambers do you have any closing remarks? The question is shall LB 12 be advanced from general file to E&R initial, all those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 11 nays, 13 not voting Mr. President.

SPEAKER: LB 12 as amended is advanced. Is there other business on the desk?

CLERK: Mr. President I have committee reports. I have an announcement Mr. President also.

SPEAKER: Read the announcement.

CLERK: Announcement read. Committee Reports read. Mr. President new bills.

SPEAKER: Read the title.
