SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President I move the adoption to E&R amendments to LB 130.

SPEAKER: The motion to adopt E&R amendments to 130, all those in favor of adopting the amendments please say aye, those opposed say no, so ordered, the amendments are adopted.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President I move the advancement of LB 130 as amended to E&R for engrossment.

SPEAKER: You've heard the motion to advance the bill as amended, all those, is there any need for discussion, all those in favor of advancing the bill as amended please say aye, those opposed say no, so ordered, the bill as amended is advanced.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President I move the adoption to E&R amendments to LB 129.

SPEAKER: You've heard the motion to adopt the amendments to LB 129, all those in favor of adopting the amendments please say aye, those opposed say no, so ordered, the amendments are adopted.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President I move be advanced, LB 129 as amended to E&R for engrossment.

SPEAKER: The motion to advance LB 129 as amended, all those in favor of advancing the bill please say aye, those opposed say no, so ordered, the bill as amended is advanced.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President I move the advancement of LB 33 to E&R for engrossment.

SPEAKER: The motion to advance LB 33, all those in favor of advancing the bill please say aye, those opposed say no, so ordered, LB 33 is advanced. Thank you Senator Cavanaugh. Now is there any motions on the desk?

CLERK: Yes Mr. President.

SPEAKER: Read the motions.

CLERK: I have a series of them, motions read.

SPEAKER: The Chair recognizes Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Mr. President, first I'd like to and I hope the body will listen to this, Senator Marvel has a bill which he is having a hearing on today, which I'm presuming I hope will be on general file soon, and then the area of the duties and the powers and the responsibilities of the Executive Board will then before this body, in order for you to make up your mind to what extent you want to change the laws pertaining to the operation of this council, as to whether or not you understand what the present laws are. Now between now and then it is my opinion that the Executive Board has adopted a policy, in the most part agreed by all with some few exceptions, that until we make some definite opinion and sense of direction the Executive Council is going to refer everything to this body for your approval, irrespective of what size it is or what it contains or what it attempts to do, now that seemed to have been the sense of direction this body has sent to this committee. The committee as well as it's Chairman has no desire to usurp any responsibilities or anything else that either the committee of this body doesn't want us to do, and if you want to become involved in everything you'll do that at least until you have an opportunity or something with the laws that now pertain to the direction of the Executive Council. Now pertaining to the motion on the Clerk's desk, and I hope that Senator Marvel will join in this and Senator Clark if he so desires. This computer situation has been going on for several years. It's been
