**SPEAKER:** State your point, Senator.

**SENATOR STAMMER:** Yes. I was given a paper by Senator Mahoney. A treatise made by a Professor at UNO and it was a very interesting paper and in it it had, I thought, a very interesting quotation and I distributed it to your desk and I thought this would commemorate our final day of putting in bills. In case anyone is criticized for putting in a lot of ideas, why, I thought this might give you a little heart and a little strength. **CLERK:** Alright.

**SPEAKER:** Very good.

**SENATOR BARNETT:** Can I have--

**SPEAKER:** Is there a second to the motion? Thank you. Senator Barnett, what's your pleasure? To move the introduction of what? You want to explain it.

**SENATOR BARNETT:** If you think it is necessary, I sure can. The idea of the bill is to revamp the motor pool or to reorganize the motor pool into an agency that would work. There have been several people made aware of the bill, what it will do. It puts the motor pool out of existence as a motor pool and puts into organization agency head as the controlling people for the motor pool. It also states that the automobiles will have to be driven a certain number of miles before state agencies can acquire a car because I understand at the present time there is a lot of confusion in motor pool. The operation is not that well and, also, the cars should be driven a minimum amount of miles before it's inexpensive to the state.
