

Thank you. Are there other committee reports? Are there any other motions on the desk?

CLERK: None Mr. President.

SPEAKER: Can move the consideration of bills on general file.

CLERK: Mr. President, I ask unanimous consent on bracket L. B. 152 signed Senator Whitney.

SPEAKER: The Chair recognizes Senator Whitney.

SENATOR WHITNEY: Mr. President, I have the amendments that members of the Legislature wanted to put on the bill all ready to go so I'm asking that it be unbracketed.

SPEAKER: Senator Whitney asking unanimous consent to unbracket 152 and take it up at this time. Are there any objections? Any objections? Hearing none it is so ordered. We will move to the general file consideration of Senator Whitney's 152.

CLERK: (inaudible) the title to the bill had been read on January 31st. Committee amendments were adopted, some amendments offered by Senator Whitney were adopted. There are now further amendments on page 4, line 18 insert (read). (amendments read).

SPEAKER: The Chair recognizes Senator Whitney.

SENATOR WHITNEY: Mr. President, Members of the Legislature, I move that these amendments be adopted. Senator Simpson had requested they be a maximum limit put in there so I have done so, it is on page 2, line 19 (read), which means that they cannot go over 25%. Now the Roads Department would not have permitted that anyway but it appeared that it was necessary to put some limitation in the bill and then there was difficulty in the bill to discover exactly where it made references to exact weights that should be put on the permits and so this amendment inserts that into the present law so that the present law will be more explicit.

SPEAKER: Any further discussion of the amendment? Chair recognizes Senator Simpson.

SENATOR SIMPSON: Mr. President, Members of the Legislature, I have seen the amendment and this would clear any opposition that I had to the bill.

SPEAKER: Any further discussion of the amendment? All those in favor of adopting the Whitney amendment as explained say aye. Those opposed say no. It is so ordered, the amendment is adopted. Senator Whitney, what is your pleasure?

SENATOR WHITNEY: Now I move that the bill be advanced to the E&R initial. We have explained this bill, it's very necessary that we have it. I don't see any objection to the bill whatsoever. We've talked over with the Roads Department, there's no fiscal impact so far as the State Patrol's concerned, no fiscal impact so far as the Motor Vehicles Department is concerned and yesterday I visited with the Fiscal Analysts and there is no a bill required because the Roads Department says that they feel that they will be able to handle this on the basis of just fit it into their existing load.

SPEAKER: Is there any further discussion of the bill as amended? Question is shall L.B. 152 as amended be advanced from general file to E&R initial. All those in favor vote aye all those opposed vote no. Voting on the advancement of L.B. 152 from general file. Have you all voted? Once again, have
