**SPEAKER:** The bill is passed. Attention please the final bill on final reading

**ASSISTANT CLERK:** Motion upset Mr. President.

**SPEAKER:** Pardon me.

**ASSISTANT CLERK:** I move that LB 101 be sent to select file for a specific amendment, to insert the emergency clause, signed Senator Carpenter.

**SPEAKER:** The Chair recognizes Senator Carpenter.

**SENATOR CARPENTER:** Mr. President, I do this first in order to ask Senator Schmit a question.

**SPEAKER:** Senator Schmit will you yield to a question?

**SENATOR SCHMIT:** I yield.

**SENATOR CARPENTER:** I think that this bill has a great deal of importance. It doesn't contain the emergency clause. To put it on there if the Senator has no objection will only delay the bill a couple of days, rather than six or seven months. Are you in concurrence to the amendment or do you object to it?

**SENATOR SCHMIT:** I have no objection, Senator Carpenter.

**SENATOR CARPENTER:** Then I so move.

**SPEAKER:** The motion is to return LB 101 to select file for specific amendment that'd be to add the emergency clause, all those in favor of that motion vote aye, all those opposed vote no. The Chair would observe that it would take 33 votes in order to move the bill back at this point, to add the emergency clause. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

**ASSISTANT CLERK:** 39 ayes, 0 nays, 10 not voting on the motion to return.

**SPEAKER:** Very good, the motion carries, and the bill is returned to select file. We are very pleased this morning to have two special visitors here, they are seated under the south balcony, we have Jim Bowie, who is Director of the Midwestern office of the Council of State Government, also accompanying him is Tom Manteuffel who is the Staff Associate and members of the body are invited over to say hellow and to greet Jim and his friend, and assistant. We are pleased to have you here and we certainly welcome you to the Nebraska Unicameral Legislature.
