SENATOR CARPENTER: I don't..have you read Section 1308.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Wait just a minute. I'll pull it out for you. I did the other night at the apartment. I've got it in front of me.

SENATOR CARPENTER: ?? 1308.01.

SENATOR GOODRICH: That's right.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Where in that, for example, does it allow you to do what you say you are trying to do. In other words, I don't find anywhere in the bill and I could be wrong that it does what the Committee chairman's statement says it wants to do. The only change you've made, for example, is the new language which is underlined which refers to 79-1301-01 which says, "provided that the provision of this section shall not apply to the investment of school funds as authorized in this section." I don't see anywhere in the bill that does what you think it wants to do. In fact, you are leaving the present method exactly as it is as I understand it. Section 2 you are referring to the original Section but replacing in that all the matter that originally existed in the old law except you add this underlined matter and I don't see that is pertinent to what you are trying to do. Maybe it is.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Let me..ask you another question. Let's keep talking about this. For example, in the repeal of the section of the bill, Section 2, that does nothing but repeal the old section and substitute Section 1 of the bill as the new language of the old Section 77 23 50.01. Right.

SENATOR CARPENTER: But at that point, you reinstate all the language of the previous law. The only new matter is, of course, you put in this underlined language.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Right. I'm trying to follow. What's the question from that point.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Well, I don't think your bill does what you say you intend to do by the Committee statement and that brings up the second question. I don't know what you are trying to accomplish by putting the new matter as underlined in your bill.

SENATOR GOODRICH: All we are trying to accomplish in adding the new material is that we can
