an existing paragraph and the amendment merely separated into a paragraph A and B. The language and the substance and the purpose is identical. If you want I can explain it or Senator Carstens can go ahead and explain the meaning of the amendment and the bill itself.

SPEAKER: Take your choice. Senator Fred Carstens do you want -

SENATOR CARSTENS: I would move that the amendments be adopted and taken up because actually that's the bill, all it did, I remember, I recall now, they just separated the bill into two separate sections, or paragraphs.

SPEAKER: Very good, proceed, then Senator Fellman.

SENATOR FELLMAN: The purpose of this bill is to give the title insurance companies of Nebraska an additional policy to sell and the people of Nebraska an opportunity I think as Fred Carstens said save lawyers fees, especially lawyers out of town in New York, or Chicago. At the present time the person who buys a house has an option of buying a title insurance policy, or going to a lawyer and having a title opinion prepared and using that as a basis for his purchase, but a public organization such as a school district or a utility district doesn't have clear authority to do the same thing. What this bill does is give statutory authority for the issuance of a policy guaranteeing that a utility or school district or
