SPEAKER: Roll call. Have you all indicated your presence? Clerk will record.

CLERK: Quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER: Thank you. Are there corrections for the Journal?

CLERK: Yes, Mr. President (corrections read). That's all Mr. President.

SPEAKER: Are there corrections from the floor? If not, the Journal will stand corrected. Do we have any notices of committee hearings?

CLERK: Committee hearings read.

SENATOR PROUD: Mr. President, I have an announcement. The Nebraska Stockgrowers dinner that was scheduled this evening at the Nebraska Club has been canceled due to road conditions and the fact that the stock growers cannot leave their cattle during this kind of weather. Two of the officials called me. They are very sorry but they will try to reschedule the dinner at a later date.

SPEAKER: Thank you. We have no more notices of committee hearings or reports? Ready for the bills on--

CLERK: None, Mr. President. Mr. President, we have a request--

SPEAKER: Very good, take up the request.

CLERK: We have a request to bracket L.B. 104 for two weeks on general file, signed Senator Syas.

SPEAKER: Senator Syas, what is your pleasure regarding 104?

SENATOR SYAS: Bracket it for two weeks, some people outstate and in Lincoln asked me to do that so they could look over the bill better. We've got plenty of time in this Legislature to take care of it.

SPEAKER: Thank you. Are there objections to bracketing L.B. 104 for two weeks. Any objections? Hearing none, it is so ordered, the bill is bracketed. And then, if we could begin to clear the floor, we could take up the bills on final reading, get the Senators in their seats. First bill on final reading this morning will be L.B. 90.

SENATOR BURBACH: Mr. President.

SPEAKER: Senator Burbach for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR BURBACH: While we're waiting a few moments to get started on the final reading, could I make a request that we bring back 132, the second bill, for a specific amendment, bring it back to select file. There is an error in 132.

SPEAKER: Senator Burbach is asking--

SENATOR BURBACH: There is an error in 132 and I want to bring it back to select file for a specific amendment.

SPEAKER: Senator Burbach, do you have the specific amendment? Senator Burbach is asking unanimous consent to return L.B. 132 to select file for a specific amendment. Are there any objections? Senator Burbach, maybe you'd better read -- well, we'll hold on that motion then until we finish L.B. 90. Once again the Chair would ask you to please take your seats so we can begin final reading.
