

Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E&R amendments to L.B. 102.

SPEAKER: Motion is to adopt the amendments to L.B. 102. All those in favor of the motion say aye. I heard no ayes. Thank you. All those opposed say no. It is so ordered, the amendments are adopted.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move that L.B. 102 as amended be advanced to E&R for Engrossment.

SPEAKER: Motion is to advance L.B. 102 as amended. All those in favor of advancing the bill, say aye. Those opposed say no. It is so ordered, the bill as amended is advanced.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E&R amendments to L.B. 291.

SPEAKER: Motion is to adopt the amendments to L.B. 291. All those in favor of that motion say aye. Those opposed say no. It is so ordered, the amendments are adopted.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move that L.B. 291 as amended be advanced to E&R for Engrossment.

SPEAKER: Motion is to advance L.B. 291 as amended. All those in favor of advancing the bill say aye. Those opposed say no. It is so ordered, the bill is advanced.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E&R amendments to L.B. 247.

SPEAKER: Motion is to adopt the amendments to L.B. 247. Do we have something on the desk? All those in favor of adopting the amendment, please say aye. Those opposed say no. It is so ordered, the amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, a motion pending from Senator Goodrich. (motion read)

SPEAKER: Senator Goodrich, we have your unanimous consent motion for 247. Chair recognizes Senator Goodrich.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Mr. President and Members of the body. This, you will recall, is the bill we were discussing the other day relative to permitting boards of education to deposit funds in certificates of deposit without being subjected to the pro rata section of the statutes. That was for the purpose of getting them in largest quantities possible and after some discussion on the floor here, we adopted an amendment to the bill which, frankly, after having sufficient amount of time to review it, we found it would not do the job so, consequently, the amendment that I have proposed right now and I have cleared this amendment through Senator Carpenter and Senator Whitney, does this, it strikes the original Goodrich amendment and inserts instead this amendment which is a much clearer way of saying exactly what we're going to do. All we want to accomplish by it as I said the other day, was to exempt certificates of deposits from the pro rata section and if the Clerk would read this amendment, you'll see that it does that in much simpler language than we were doing the other day. If there are any questions, I will be glad to answer them but in the meantime, I move the adoption of this amendment.

SPEAKER: Are there any objections? Do you all understand the amendment. Question is shall the amendment be adopted and Senator Goodrich is asking unanimous consent. Are there any objections to the motion? Any objections? Hearing none it is so ordered, the amendment is adopted into L.B. 247. Senator Cavanaugh, back to you then on 247.
