CLERK: 26 ayes, no nays, 23 not voting Mr. President.

SPEAKER: The bill is advanced. Brings up LB 169, Senator Richendifer's bill.

CLERK: Title Read LB 169. There are no committee amendments or other amendments pending.

SPEAKER: The Chair recognizes Senator Richendifer.

SENATOR RICHENDIFER: Mr. President I move that LB 169 be advanced to E&R initial. This bill harmonizes the workman's compensation card with the district courts. In that it allows attorney fees on rehearings when the award is not reduced by the court. It's very simple, if the employer wishes to ask for a rehearing or his counsel to the three man court and the award that was given by the one man in court is not reduced, the court may rule that the attorney's expenses be paid by the employer. This will reduce the amount of rehearing cases, and probably stop flagrant delays in court hearings and compensation court.

SPEAKER: Is there any further discussion of the bill? The question is shall LB 169 be advanced from general file to E&R initial? All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. We are voting on the advancement of Senator Richendifer's LB 169 from general file to E&R initial. Have you all voted? Once again have you all voted. The Clerk will record. Senator Richendifer has asked for a call of the house, the clerk will clear the board. Senator Richendifer has made a motion for a call of the house, all those in favor of a call of the house will vote aye, all those opposed will vote no. Senator Richendifer's motion is for a call of the house, that is the measure under vote at this time. Have you all voted? Once again have you all voted. Senator Waldron voting aye on the original motion. We've got to go under call of the house before you can call it in Senator Waldron. Alright the Clerk will record.

CLERK: 21 ayes, to go under call Mr. President.

SPEAKER: Motion fails,

CLERK: No.

SPEAKER: Whoops, wait a minute, a simple majority, I'm sorry, whoops, whoops, we are under call of the house, now Senator Waldron, what was your pleasure?

CLERK: Senator Waldron voting aye in the original motion.
