SENATOR NORE: Mr. President and fellow members, I am not opposed to ADC. I am not opposed to other handouts which we all receive a few. However, I think we should look back in the history of the Roman Empire. What destroyed it? It was the organized idle poor and the organized idle rich and as it progressed there were less and less folks in the middle who worked, so we ended up with the hordes from the north coming in and taking over the Roman Empire. And that's what, probably, could happen in our great country. Idleness is the devil's workshop. It's one of the causes of some of our crime and some folks who have..in idleness get tired of life and go into drugs, etc. I think our Governor stood before us and made the statement that, probably, better, some families ?? better who are now getting along pretty well would be better if they quit their jobs and went on the public dole and this would be idleness and I want to leave with you one statement that idleness is what can destroy our country.
