and they are calling him an assistant director in order to give him his regular salary, and this limitation should have been taken off the statute, it's been there since 1943, so it's a technical thing and I would ask for the introduction of this bill.

SPEAKER: Is there any further discussion of the Senator's motion? Yes it has been referred. Any further discussion? Any closing remarks Senator Kennedy, the question is shall the bill be introduced. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Senator Kennedy is asking for the introduction of the bill, the Chair would observe that does take 30 votes. Have you all voted. I'll wait for you Senator Whitney. The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 32 ayes, no nays, 17 not voting.

SPEAKER: The bill is introduced.

CLERK: Mr. President I move for the introduction of the attached bill, a bill to be introduced by the Public Health and Welfare Committee, signed Senators Kennedy, Maresh, Goodrich, Cavanaugh and Lewis (read).

SPEAKER: The Chair recognizes Senator Kennedy.

SENATOR KENNEDY: Mr. President, fellow members, again we have the same thing that came up that there is a provision that says city of the metropolitan class, the city council, and we are striking that and putting in any city, village, county, or township, the governing body, now this would cover all bodies that might want to do this and it's not demanding but it gives information to pay the services of the visiting nurse and this would be for vaccinations and different things, and they are doing it in some places illegal, and this was found out so this again is a technical matter that would give those people the privilege of doing what they want to do. If there is any questions, otherwise I would ask for this introduction of this bill also by the committee.

SPEAKER: Any further discussion of the motion? The question is shall the bill be introduced, all those in favor will vote aye, all those opposed vote no. You're voting on Senator Kennedy's motion to introduce a bill.

SENATOR KENNEDY: I don't know if we need a call of the house maybe not, we need 30 votes, thank you.

SPEAKER: Have you all voted. The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, no nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER: The bill is introduced. Are there any other bills on the desk?

CLERK: Yes lots of them. Mr. President I move for the introduction of the attached bill, signed Senator Mahoney (read).

SPEAKER: The Chair recognizes Senator Mahoney.

SENATOR MAHONEY: Mr. Chairman this bill, it come to the Executive Board, and originally it was one of the bills that was asked to be referred to a committee and I've gone to the five members of the Executive Board, and it has to do with the increase of mileage for state employees.
