SENATOR MAHONEY: Mr. President this was a bill that had to be brought into the legislation, it came in late and it had to do with water pollution funds and it sorta correlates with the Federal laws, and it's necessary that it have a hearing and that's why the Executive Board put it in.

SPEAKER: Just for the sake of the record, let's go back to the previous motion, Senator Mahoney asked unanimous consent to withdraw his motion regarding introduction of the bill, are there any objections to that? Hearing none, so ordered, then the bill is withdrawn. Now we are back to Senator Mahoney's motion regarding this particular bill, is there need for further discussion? Senator Mahoney is asking for the introduction of the bill, all those in favor will vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Once again the Chair might remind the body, that it does take 30 votes for the introduction of a new bill. Have you all voted, we are voting on the introduction of a new
