CLERK: Goodrich voting no.

SPEAKER: On the original motion.

CLERK: Senator Keyes voting aye on the original motion.

SPEAKER: Yes, please record your presence. The House is under call, please remain in your seats. Who is absent Mr. Clerk? Senator Goodrich.

SENATOR GOODRICH: I move to raise the call.

CLERK: Senator Kelly voting aye on the original motion.

SPEAKER: The motion has been made to raise the call, all those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. The Clerk will record. Senator Duis voting aye on the original motion.

CLERK: Senator Duis voting aye on the original motion. 32 ayes Mr. President to raise the call.

SPEAKER: The call has been raised, the Clerk will announce the vote on the original motion.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 2 nays, remainder not voting.

SPEAKER: The motion carries, Senator Carpenter, what will you do with the bill?

CLERK: Now, Mr. President, there is another motion, I move to return LB 12 to select file for the following specific amendment. (read)

SENATOR CARPENTER: I move for adoption, now what this amendment does is two things, in the original bill the Mayor was a part of the city council which obviously I don't presume is acceptable. It changes the date from 1973 until I think 1977. Obviously the bill because of the lacking of the emergency clause could not be effective in 1973, and that within the opinion of some people would make the bill completely invalid. Now the point is insofar as I'm concerned, do we want to know pass the bill in proper shape and proper form so it will be effective in 1977, and I move the bill be taken back to select file for this specific amendment.

SPEAKER: You have heard the motion is there any discussion? Seeing none the question is shall this bill be returned to select file for specific amendments, if it is then we take up the amendments, but not until it is returned if it is. All those in favor of returning the bill to select file vote aye, those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 1 nay, 21 not voting Mr. President, on the motion to return.

SPEAKER: The bill has now been returned to select file, Senator Carpenter what will you do with the bill?

CLERK: Now Mr. President we would have a motion to adopt the specific amendment on select file.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I so move.

SPEAKER: Are you ready for the question? The question is shall the amendments proposed by Senator Carpenter be adopted? All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. Have you all
